A Polish student looking to get a visa for Iraq will generally need to follow these steps:

1. Determine the Type of Visa Needed

Since you're a student, you may need either:

- A **tourist visa** (if visiting temporarily)
- A **student visa** (if studying in Iraq)
- A **business or special visa** (if attending conferences, research, etc.)

2. Check Visa Requirements

Polish citizens usually need a visa to enter Iraq. Requirements can vary, so check with the Iraqi Embassy in Poland or the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Iraq.

Typically, required documents include:

- A valid passport (at least 6 months validity)
- A completed visa application form
- ✓ Passport-sized photos
- Proof of accommodation in Iraq
- ✓ Travel itinerary (flight bookings)
- ✓ Invitation letter (if applicable)
- Proof of financial means
- ✓ Visa fee payment

For student visas, you may also need:

- An official acceptance letter from an Iraqi university
- ✓ Proof of tuition payment or financial sponsorship

3. Apply for the Visa

- Iraqi Embassy in Poland: Submit your application in person.
- **E-Visa (if applicable):** Some types of visas may be available online.
- Visa on Arrival (Limited Availability): Some travelers can get visas at Baghdad or Erbil airports, but this is not guaranteed for Polish citizens.

4. Wait for Processing

Visa processing can take **several days to weeks**, depending on the type.

5. Travel to Iraq

Once approved, ensure you **carry all required documents** when entering Iraq, as border officials may ask for additional verification.
