








The ziggurat at Ur as it appeared c. 2100 BCE.





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International and national cooperation... France



Professor Dr. Kadhim Abbood Al-Majdi met with the Scientific and University Cooperation Attaché at the French Embassy in Baghdad, Ms. Bernadette Chew, on Thursday, 02/08/2024, to discuss ways of scientific cooperation in the field of summer training for university students in the specializations of pharmacy, dentistry, and medical laboratory techniques, as a first step towards developing skills, practical students to be a nucleus for expanding the program towards other specializations.

The Attaché for Scientific and Academic Cooperation at the French Embassy praised this project and the proposed training sessions as the first private university to take this step and hopes for its success in the future after completing all procedures. She promised to work on approaching universities, institutions and training centers in France through them to be a key factor in the success of the training program. Visit of the French Cultural Attaché to the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research


- On Monday 10/14/2024, Prof. Dr. Kadhim Al-Majidi, President of Ashur University, met with the French Cultural Attaché at the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Ms. Bernadette Chio.
- The meeting was attended by the Scientific Assistant to the President of the University, the Advisor to the President of the University, and the Director of Scholarships and Cultural Relations at the University.







The meeting discussed the distinguished opportunities for cooperation between Ashur University and French universities and institutions in medical and engineering specialties and all of our university specialties. At the forefront of these opportunities was the realization of the summer school opportunity for Ashur University students in all specialties, which contributes to developing the knowledge and capabilities of university students and introducing them to new and advanced learning means in France. This will be achieved in the summer of the current academic year, God willing. The Japanese delegation at Ashur

University

The President of Ashur University, Prof. Dr. Kadhim Al-Majidi, met today, Tuesday 10/22/2024, with the **Japanese** academic delegation consisting of Professor Dr. Keiko Sakai, Dean of the Institute for International Crisis Relations at Chiba University, and Professor Dr. Kaoru Yamamoto, a lecturer at Keio University in Japan, accompanied by the head of the cultural department at the Japanese Embassy. In his meeting, the President of the University discussed opportunities for scientific, academic and cultural cooperation between Ashur and University the **Japanese** Universities of Chiba and Keio, in addition to cultural cooperation with the Japanese Embassy in Baghdad. The guests from the Japanese delegation were introduced during the meeting to the university, its departments and capabilities.







During the meeting, Prof. Dr. Kadhim Al-Majidi, President of Ashur University, expressed the university's readiness to open up to Japanese universities and academic institutions in the fields of research, students and staff exchange, holding workshops and seminars, and establishing research projects that meet the needs of the labor market in all specializations. The Director of the Scholarships and Cultural Relations Division of Ashur University gave an introductory presentation about Ashur University, its vision, goals, mission, and its keenness to develop opportunities for scientific cooperation and conclude agreements with distinguished international institutions and universities. The university was also introduced through a video that showed the Japanese delegation the university's facilities, colleges, sports center, hospital, and medical centers. The Japanese delegation was also taken on an introductory tour to the dental clinics, the College of Medicine facilities, and then the swimming pool, the bowling hall, and the university's sports stadium, where a football game was held for girls' cubs, as one of the activities through which Ashur University seeks to serve the local community. 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Ashur University Electronic System

- Overview of the System
- Ashur electronic system is designed to enhance the **administrative** functions of educational institutions. By streamlining processes related to **student management**, **maintaining organized records** and facilitating efficient operations.
- The university electronic system is a comprehensive solution for managing student information and improving academic processes. By incorporating advanced management features and robust reporting capabilities, the system plays a crucial role in fostering student success and optimizing administrative efficiency in higher education settings. This integrated approach provides a seamless experience from admission through graduation.

Functional Components of the System

Student Information Database

- Data Structure: The system hosts a relational database designed to store extensive information about students, academic history, enrollment status, and Tuition fees.
- Data Access: Administrative staff have controlled access to edit, update, and maintain the integrity of the student records, ensuring data security and privacy.

Fee Management Module

• **Payment Tracking**: The system allows finance department staff to view fee details, track payments, and access payment histories.

Performance Calculation Engine

•GPA Calculation: The system employs algorithms to calculate grade point average (GPA) and final year grade by applying appropriate weightings to various assessments.

Academic Vocabulary Contro

•Standardization Protocols: The system includes features that allow administrators to define and update academic terms in line with university requirements. This ensures consistency in communication and documentation across students, faculty, and administrative units.

Reporting and Analytics

• Automated Reporting: Comprehensive reports on student absences and displaying graphs and statistics of success and failure rates, and showing the top students, each divided according to his grade, department, type of study, and gender.

User Experience

- **Interface Design**: The user interface is designed with ease of use in mind, providing straightforward navigation for administrative staff.
- Help and Support: Integrated help features by system admins offer staff guidance on navigating the system, ensuring that users can effectively utilize all functions.

The Bologna Process in Iraq.

- The Bologna Process is a collaborative framework aimed at harmonizing higher education systems in Europe. It was first signed in 1999 by the education ministers of 29 European countries, and has since been joined by 49 more.
- It is a multi-purpose process that aims to develop a framework that makes higher education qualifications comparable in their certificates and information, facilitates the comparison of university degrees across the European Union, enables the adoption of similar quality standards and helps higher education in student employability and global competitiveness.



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
















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
